

## THE LOCATION

The former Poet Laureate, Sir John Betjeman, described Bristol as ‘the most beautiful, interesting and distinguished city in England.’

Even Londoners who swear they could never live anywhere other than the capital are tempted by Bristol. Cosmopolitan Bristol offers the dynamism, creativity, history and cool of London, but on a more human scale and with a laid-back confidence.

Around the vibrant city of Bristol is a variety of beautiful countryside within easy reach. The Avon Gorge and surrounding hills provide a magnificent setting for the city itself; to the north are the Cotswolds; to the west lie Devon and Cornwall; to the south we have Somerset and the Cheddar Gorge; and to the east is the world-famous Stonehenge – well worth an optional visit.

## THE CENTRE

ISIS Bristol takes place at the University of the West of England (UWE), Frenchay Campus. UWE is one of the UK’s most modern and rapidly expanding universities. With over 30,000 students during the year, it is also one of the most popular with students who are drawn to the city of Bristol itself and the modern teaching and accommodation facilities. The campus is located about 6km from the city centre.
