

THE LOCATION

Cirencester is an historic Roman town in the county of Gloucestershire. It is popularly known as the 'capital of the Cotswolds': a region world famous for its chocolate box idyllic beauty. This picturesque and ancient town shows English architecture at its most traditional.

Cirencester is within easy reach of London, Oxford and Bath for full-day excursions. Optional trips might include Cheltenham, Bristol and Stratford-upon-Avon.

THE CENTRE
