

THE LOCATION

Royal Holloway College is centred around the Victorian gothic splendor of the Founder's Building, home to the women's only college which opened there in 1886. Now Royal Holloway is part of the University of London, and has state of the art academic buildings as well as modern accommodation blocks, set in a large leafy campus.

The nearby town of Egham is a 20 minute walk from the campus, just over 10km from Heathrow airport, and just over 30 km from central London. It has excellent international access, as well as easy routes to London, the South coast and central England. Regular trains from Egham run to Waterloo in under an hour, from where students can explore the best of London by foot.

THE CENTRE

The accommodation is all recently renovated, and single and twin en-suite rooms are arranged around shared kitchens. The students can walk easily from their residence to the canteen and to classes in this secure closed campus away from the hustle and bustle of central London. ISIS also makes use of the great on-site facilities including a large sports hall, tennis courts and outdoor playing fields.

Visits to the city are a central part of the activity programme, including the very popular river boat disco on the Thames. Students will also enjoy two full day trips to London, as well as full-day trips to Windsor, Brighton and Oxford. The academic programme makes the most of London and Windsor as resources, with link lessons drawing on history and British culture to supplement the students' learning experience.
