

THE LOCATION

Guildford is the historic and vibrant county town of Surrey and the gateway to some of the most stunning scenery in the South East of England. Guildford has all the richness and amenities of a city and yet remains compact enough to explore and enjoy with ease. In the streets and lanes around the cobbled High Street, there awaits a wealth of history to discover including the castle built by William and Conqueror and the house of the author Lewis Carroll. THE CENTRE

The University of Surrey is based on a modern, leafy campus offering students an engaging environment to stay and study in. The many striking, modern buildings sit on the hillside leading up to Guildford Cathedral, which dominates the campus from every angle. The college buildings are surrounded by landscaped grounds, trees and a lake home to an array of ducks and swans.

Although a safe and secure campus, the college is a very short walk to the city centre and to Guildford Train station, from where trains run directly to Waterloo Station – thus opening up the whole of central London on foot. Our programme makes use of this proximity to offering a weekly full day in London by train. The centre is also blessed by being close to a number of popular destinations apart from London, including Oxford, Thorpe Park, Winchester, Windsor and Brighton.

In terms of teaching and learning, the classrooms are modern, spacious and bright in keeping with the University's desire to be a world class seat of learning. Other on-site facilities include outdoor and indoor sports areas, social room, bank, bookshop, mini-market and laundry.
